



FAST FACTS: PLANNED PARENTHOOD 2022-2023 ANNUAL REPORT

- Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA) committed 392,715 abortions in FY 2022 (July 1, 2022—June 30, 2023), killing an average of 1,076 unborn babies per day, an increase from 1,025 per day in FY 2021.¹
- Although PPFA’s report does not provide a breakdown of the methods it uses to kill the unborn, PPFA President Alexis McGill Johnson has stated that over 70 percent are carried out via the abortion drug mifepristone.²
 - » This means at least 274,901 abortions were carried out using mifepristone in FY 2022, leaving hundreds of thousands of women alone to deal with the emotional and physical tolls of using the abortion drug to end their children’s lives.
 - » Per the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s (CDC) own label, 2.9 to 4.6 percent of women taking mifepristone will end up in the emergency room.³ This translates to between 22 and 35 women per day and between 7,972 and 12,645 in FY 2022.
- In the past five fiscal years, PPFA killed 1,850,873 unborn babies through abortion. The babies killed in FY 2019 would have been entering kindergarten this year. Those killed in 2022 would be taking their first steps. PPFA is killing America’s future.

- A CDC report dated November 2023 states that 625,978 abortions were reported to the federal government in 2021.⁹ In FY 2021, PPFA committed 374,155 abortions.¹⁰ This means PPFA accounted for approximately 60 percent of all U.S. abortions reported in 2021, making it America’s largest abortion supplier.

DECREASE IN PATIENTS AND OTHER “SERVICES”

- PPFA reported 2.05 million patients in FY 2022,¹¹ a decrease from 2.13 million in FY 2021.¹²
- In FY 2022, “breast care” decreased to 212,655.¹³ This is an 81 percent drop from a high of 1,100,901 in 1999.¹⁴
- In FY 2022, prenatal services decreased to 6,316.¹⁵ PPFA does not disclose what constitutes “prenatal services.”
- In FY 2022, PPFA committed approximately 228 abortions for every adoption referral it made (1,721 total).¹⁶ This is 82 fewer referrals than in FY 2021.¹⁷

EVEN PLANNED PARENTHOOD KNOWS ABORTION AND MISCARRIAGE AREN'T THE SAME

- In FY 2022, PPFA reported 3,604 instances of miscarriage care.¹⁸ By placing miscarriage care in its own category, PPFA's report acknowledges that these cases are distinct from abortions (despite pro-abortion assertions to the contrary). In a miscarriage, the death of the baby is not intentionally caused, unlike in an abortion.
- It has been reported that the abortion industry advises women who self-manage their abortion through the use of the abortion drug mifepristone to lie to healthcare providers and claim they are experiencing a miscarriage if complications arise. It is possible that these "miscarriage services" include completing the abortion surgically.¹⁹

ABORTION PROMOTION

- In FY 2022, PPFA assisted 33,000 people who were seeking abortions and supplied over 15,000 people with the finances to travel for an abortion.²⁰
- In FY 2022, PPFA supplied funds for over 50,000 women's abortions.²¹
- PPFA has 30 open cases challenging laws protecting unborn babies from being killed by abortion in 16 states as well as federal policies.²²
- In FY 2022, PPFA's "educational videos" were viewed three million times.²³
- In FY 2022, PPFA's decision-making quizzes were used 653,000 times.²⁴
- In FY 2022, PPFA's chatbot was used 604,000 times.²⁵

OWNING THE INTERNET

- In FY 2022, PPFA partnered with 28 social media influencers to reach 34.7 million followers, likely promoting their culture of death to young people.²⁶
- In 2022, PPFA hosted a conference of leading tech companies to "discuss how to improve accountability and address health care misinformation" around abortion.²⁷ Notably, major tech companies have censored pro-life groups or labeled their articles as "misinformation."²⁸



POLITICIZING THE SCIENCE

- PPFA and affiliate researchers authored 47 peer-reviewed publications with "new findings" in the field of "sexual and reproductive health."²⁹ This is akin to cigarette companies doing cancer research.

TRANSGENDER TITAN

- Of PPFA's 49 affiliates, 45 provide "gender-affirming hormone therapy."³⁰

THE ABORTION PERCENTAGE LIE

- PPFA reports that in FY 2022, abortion comprised four percent of its services.³¹ However, this number is only achieved by "unbundling" non-abortion services. PPFA counts one patient receiving a pap smear, a pregnancy test, a birth control packet, and an STD test as four services. This method of counting dilutes the numbers, deliberately minimizing PPFA's abortion activities.

A GLOBAL AGENDA

- In FY 2022, Planned Parenthood Global partnered with 80 organizations in nine countries—10 more organizations than in FY 2021.³²
- 90 percent of Planned Parenthood’s global efforts focus on countries where unborn babies have protection from abortion.³³
- In FY 2022, Planned Parenthood Global trained 28,000 people to promote its agenda of killing unborn children—16,000 more people than were trained in FY 2021.³⁴
- In FY 2022, Planned Parenthood Global held 24 events throughout Africa and Latin America,³⁵ furthering its ideological colonialism.
- In FY 2022, Planned Parenthood Global boasted about weakening 112 policies that protected the unborn in eight countries.³⁶
- In FY 2022, Planned Parenthood Global’s efforts chipped away at the complete protections for the unborn in Mexico. Due to Planned Parenthood Global’s efforts, unborn babies in Quintana Roo can now be killed through abortion up to 12 weeks gestation.³⁷

TAXPAYER DOLLARS USED FOR ABORTION

- In FY 2022, PPFA received \$699,300,000 in taxpayer dollars, four percent more than in FY 2021.³⁸ Because money is fungible, this means nearly seven million in PPFA’s budget was freed up to further fund abortions in FY 2022.

DONOR DOLLARS

- In FY 2022, private contributions and bequests to PPFA increased to \$997.5 million from \$694.9 million in FY 2021, a 44 percent increase.³⁹
